




FOUNDATION SKILLS PROGRAM

This option exists for those people located in Victoria who do not find the training of a puppy very inviting. Reasons may range from 'no time' to a disability. Basically, we train the puppy for the first 4 months, so all the foundation work is introduced.



Foundation Skills Program

This option exists for those people located in Victoria who do not find the training of a puppy very inviting. Reasons may range from 'no time' to a disability. Basically, we train the puppy for the first 4 months, so all the foundation work is introduced.

The complete cost of the 4 month program (\$12000)

- We require a payment of \$3000 at the beginning of each month.
- At the completion of the program the outstanding balance is to be paid before delivery of your dog

When the puppy comes to you at 6 months old he/ she will have been introduced to the following skills:

- Toilet on command
- Sit
- Stay
- Come/Recall.
- Down
- Walk to heel.
- Experience in traffic

Your costs also cover exposure to the following:

- Various noises (sirens, horns, thunder, trucks, cars, babies, etc.)
- Experiences (attending fetes etc.)
- Animals (exposure to cats, ducks, geese, chickens, etc.)
- Dog to Dog socialisation.
- Impulse control.

Additional expenses covered by your fees are as follows:

- Initial vaccination program
- Parasite control (worming and fleas)
- Daily food costs
- Enrichment activities
- Physical exercise
- Mental stimulation
- Cuddles!!!



NOTE

Although we arrange the desexing and after care of your puppy the above costs DO NOT cover it. We will invoice you for this when it occurs.

Other vet expenses, for injury or illness are covered up to a \$200.00 limit.

Our program includes structured training sessions with you. **NOTE** you must be able to attend training sessions at SSE in preparation for your pup coming to your home.

At the completion of the program.

- You can continue the assistance dog training via our program through to accreditation.
- Continue with another trainer.

Your pup will come to you with a training coat and ready to begin Assistance Dog training.
